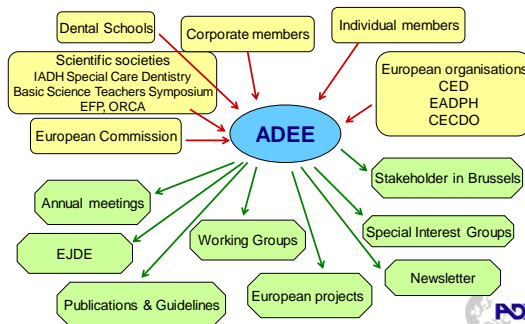

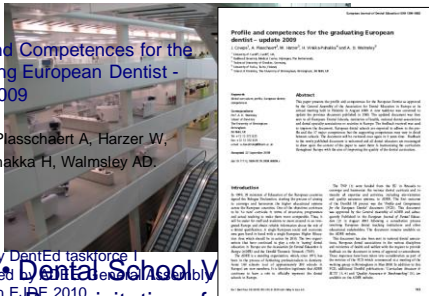

Domains **Introduction**

- Professionalism
- Interpersonal, Communication and Social Skills
- The new graduate is required to safely undertake the independent Knowledge Base, Information and Information literacy
- Practice of dentistry, Education and training programmes differ greatly between old EU countries and newly joined countries and access to higher education in the EU. It is hoped that the Major competences document will contribute to further harmonisation and convergence of dental education in Europe.

Supporting competences
The more specific abilities could be considered as subdivisions of a 'major competence' and are termed a 'supporting competence'.

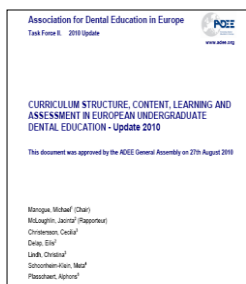
ADEE envisages that all European schools will adhere to the major competences as described in this document, but that supporting competences may vary in detail between schools.
